WHAT IS BLUE&ME™ NAV?

Blue&Me™ Nav is an innovative system developed by Fiat Group Automobiles together with Microsoft that changes the way of communicating and spending time in the car and also allows you to reach a desired location quickly and safely.

WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH BLUE&ME™ NAV?

- Make and receive calls via **Bluetooth®** using your mobile phone with this functionality.
- Display the names and numbers in the phone book on the instrument panel display.
- Use voice commands to call one of the names or numbers in the phone book without taking your hands off the steering wheel.
- Listen to MP3, WMA and WAV audio files loaded on a device with USB connections.
- Enter a new destination using steering wheel controls and voice commands.
- Navigate by the pictograms on the car's multifunctional display, listening to the voice messages via the speakers.
- Navigate to a point of interest or obtain information about your journey.
- Choose one of the last destinations stored as a destination.

If you press the button (i) during a phone call in progress, the request for information in the Service Centre can not be activated. If a telephone call is received immediately after the button is pressed (i), before the voice call can be activated the request to the **Info Service Blue&Me™ Nav** will be stopped.

N.B.: If it were necessary to replace the **Blue&Me™ Nav** device, to obtain the reactivation of the services previously subscribed to, it is good to make sure that workshop that has made the replacement, fill in the form this inside the spare parts packaging and send it by fax to the number of the Services Centre indicated.

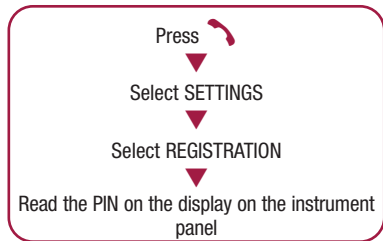

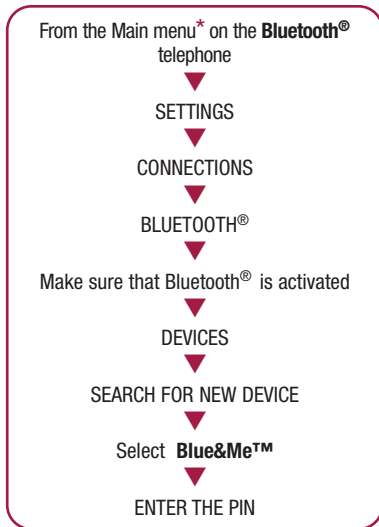
The MEDIAPLAYER does not support the playing of audio files covered by digital rights (DRM), AAC files downloaded from iTunes and MP4.

* The registration procedure is purely a guide and may vary according to the make or model of the mobile phone with Bluetooth® technology. If carried out correctly, Blue&Me™ will confirm the registration, give a welcome and ask if you wish to download the directory. This operation can only be performed on mobile phones that support this function.

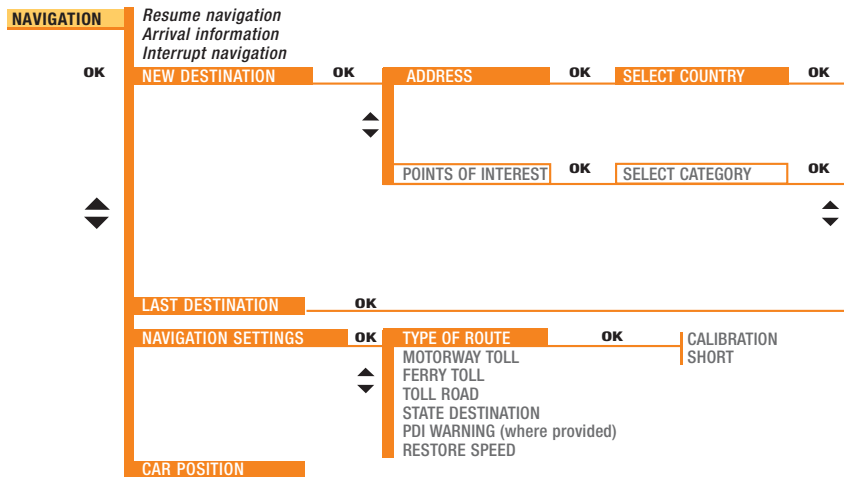
INFO SERVICE: to receive useful information during your journey (e.g. traffic conditions, flight and train timetables, useful addresses for restaurants, accommodation, museums, pharmacies, etc.) There is no fixed cost, you pay when you use the service. For details on available information and for service costs visit the website www.alfaromeo.com or freephone **800.2532.0000**.

How to use Blue&Me™ Nav INFO Service

To access the service, press the button (i) on the button surround in the front courtesy light zone. Blue&Me™ Nav will make a telephone call to the Service Centre. You can make your request with hands-free. For details of the types of information services available, refer to the **INFO Service Blue&Me™** service activation contract.

Important advice on use of SOS and INFO Services

If the service has not already been activated, pressing the specific buttons will display the message “**SERVICE NOT AVAILABLE**” on the control panel and the same message will be read by Blue&Me™ Nav. **SOS:** Any active phone call (conversation in progress) will be stopped automatically in the case of activation of the request for the **SOS Emergency** service.



NOTE: the menu items written in *italics* may appear or not depending on the conditions in which the navigator is situated.

Music is not downloaded on the car but can be managed with the steering wheel controls and vocally.

For personalised listening, check the music playing mode from the “SETTINGS” menu, scrolling until you find “M.M. PLAYER”.

Automatic Play: the files contained in the MP3 player are played automatically on turning on.

Random Play: the tracks are played in a random order.


Continuous play: the same track selected is repeated.

Or with voice interaction: Press  and say “PLAY”.


To choose music, select “MEDIA PLAYER” and then “ARTISTS” or “ALBUMS” or “GENRES”, the name of the singer and the title of the song can be selected using the controls on the steering wheel.

The first part of the selection can also be made through voice commands. You cannot make the request for the name of the singer or the song through voice commands.

PAUSE: Press **ESC** to pause the track and press again to resume playing.

To stop playing the track, press  and say the word “STOP”, press again and say the word “PLAY” to resume.

PREVIOUS OR NEXT TRACK: you can switch from one track to another by selecting .

NOTE: if playing does not start, press  say “STOP”, press again  and say “PLAY”.

SERVICES FOR YOU

A specific subscription is needed to activate the services using the appropriate contract that can be downloaded from the website www.alfaromeo.com or contact Fiat Group Automobiles dealerships and follow the instructions on the form.

SOS EMERGENCY SERVICE: health care and roadside assistance free for the first two years of the car's warranty.

How to use the SOS Emergency Service



To make a request for help from the Service Centre, press the **SOS** button located in the area of the front ceiling courtesy light. The system will forward the emergency request to the Service Centre operator after a safety period of several seconds to prevent accidental activation of the service. If the **SOS** service call does not work, start the automatic call to the emergency number.

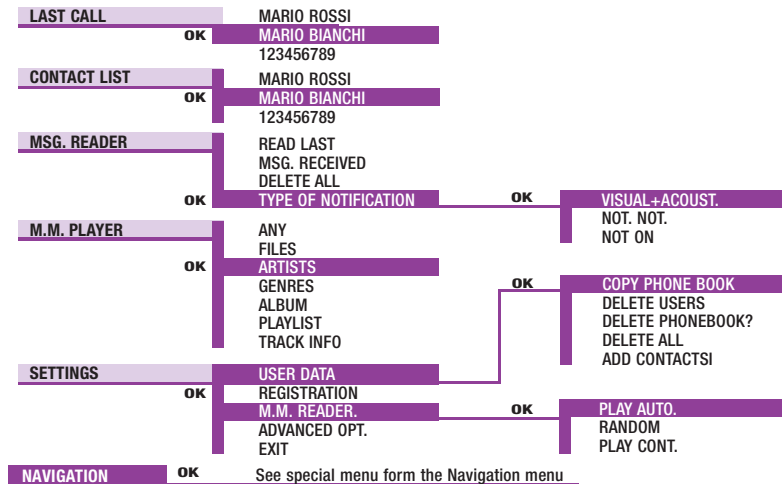
Blue&Me™ Nav will issue a voice message and an alarm during the safety period. The request for help can be interrupted by pressing the **SOS** button again within the safety period shown on the control panel.

After the safety time, **Blue&Me™ Nav** will automatically send an SMS message to the Service Centre containing the GPS position of your car. At the same time it will make a voice telephone call to the Service Centre and you can speak to a dedicated Operator using hands-free to make your request.

The **SOS** service is free for the first 2 years of the car's life.

BLUE&ME™ NAV MAIN MENU

You can activate the **Blue&Me™ Nav** menu either from the steering wheel controls by pressing the button  or vocally, by pressing the handsfree button  and saying the function that you want to activate out loud. Follow the order shown below:




If the car engine is turned off by turning the ignition key in STOP position during an **SOS Emergency** service request, this will be anyway completed only with the sending of the SMS message. If the car is switched off by removing the electronic key from the ignition device during an active call with the operator of the Central Services, this will remain active until the end of the call or after 15 minutes of conversation.

If there is no GSM signal the message “**NO GSM SIGNAL**“ will be displayed on the control panel and the red LED on the button surround will be switched on.

N.B. In this situation it is not possible to send the SOS Emergency service request to the Service Centre.

DriveMe Service: to receive the required destination via SMS by speaking to an Info Service operator without needing to switch it on manually. There is no fixed cost, you only pay for the call to the **INFO** service. For details on available information and for service costs visit the site www.alfaromeo.com or freephone **800.2532.0000**.

How to use the Blue&Me DriveMe Service: to access the service contact an Info Service operator by pressing the button  on the button surround in the front courtesy light zone. Then request the desired destination and the **Blue&Me™ Nav** will automatically receive an SMS from DriveMe containing the requested destination which will be displayed on the control panel multifunctional display, by automatically programming the navigation system. If the destination matched a telephone number and your mobile phone with **Bluetooth®** is connected to **Blue&Me™ Nav**, you can call the number by selecting the option CALL.

WHAT DO YOU HAVE TO DO BEFORE USING BLUE&ME™ NAV?

For correct use of the hands-free and media player functionality first of all you have to configure the system in this way:

- Activate the mobile phone in **Bluetooth®** mode.
- Register the mobile phone with **Blue&Me™ Nav**, only necessary the first time.
- Download the phone book.
- Keep the mobile phone in **Bluetooth®** mode, so that **Blue&Me™ Nav** will recognise it each time you get into your car.

To correctly use the Navigation function you must proceed as follows:

- Connect the USB stick with the preloaded map from the Navigation kit to the USB port.
- Enter the destination and start the navigation as described earlier.
- You can also use your multimedia player or USB stick on which you have downloaded the music and the map to make the navigation and hear your favourite tracks at the same time.

To optimise the connection of your iPod with Blue&Me™ Nav, in general it is necessary to carry out some simple operations on your iPod:

- Configure the iPod for use as an external disc, referring to the instruction manual for different iPod versions;
- if the configuration is done on an Apple Mac, configure using a Windows format;
- save the music tracks as MP3 files, not protected from copying.

These operations do not adversely affect the listening quality nor the usability of tracks managed by iPods.

VOICE INTERACTION

Short press

- Activates voice interaction.
- By saying "HELP" you get help during any menu option.
- Interrupts a voice announcement to make another one.

Long press

- Repeat the last phrase of **Blue&Me™ Nav** (except during navigation)

SAY THE NUMBER YOU WISH TO CALL

Press and say "CALL": **Blue&Me™ Nav** will ask you for "THE NUMBER, PLEASE": say the number, digit by digit. If one of the digits has not been received correctly, say "DELETE" otherwise confirm by saying "YES".

SAY THE NAME FROM THE PHONEBOOK (if downloaded)

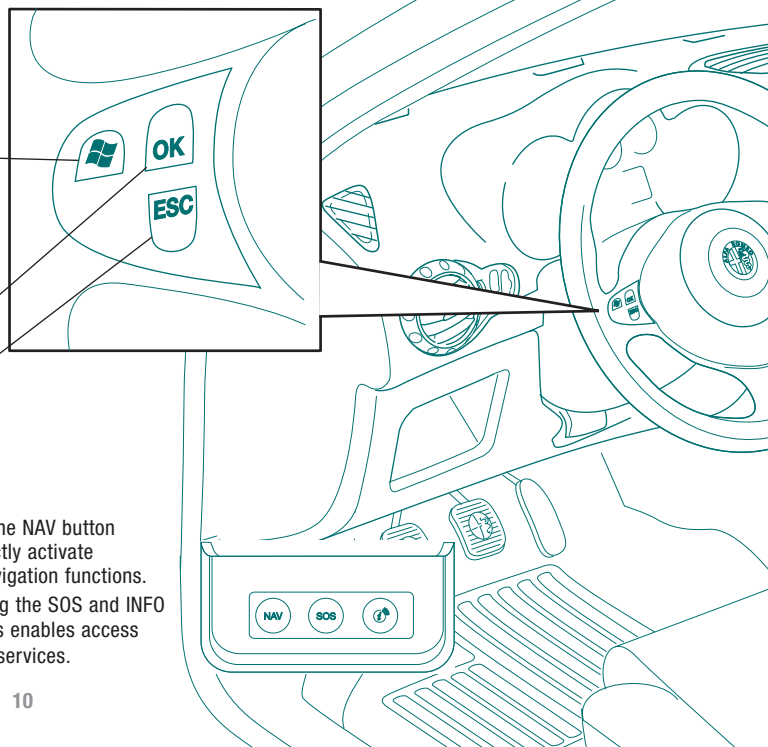
Press and say "CALL" followed by the name (as written in the mobile phone).

OK

- Confirms the **Blue&Me™** menu item
- Transfers the conversation from **Blue&Me™** to the mobile phone and vice versa.
- Selects the SMS text message displayed.

ESC

- Ends a voice interaction.
- Interrupts the reading of an SMS text message.
- Exits a submenu and returns to the previous menu item.
- Deactivates the microphone during a conversation.
- Adds and removes the pausing of the multimedia player whilst playing.



- Press the NAV button to directly activate the Navigation functions.
- Pressing the SOS and INFO buttons enables access to the services.

COMPATIBILITY iPod



What you can do

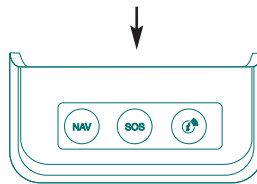
- Listen to MP3 tracks in digital quality
- Select tracks (by artist, album, genre, etc.) through voice control or by using the controls on the steering wheel
- Store music and maps to navigate and listen to your favourite tracks at the same time
- Display information about the track being played (song title, singer, etc.) on the instrument panel.
- Recharge your iPod through the USB.

What you cannot do


Play tracks in AAC, m4a, m4p and mp4 format or purchased from iTunes or digitally protected (DRM) or tracks from iPod touch or iPhone devices.

When the USB device containing the map has been connected to the USB port, with the electronic key inserted in the ignition key in MAR position and with the vehicle stationary, there are three ways to start:

1. Press the steering wheel control  and say "Navigation";
2. Press the MENU button  and scroll through the menu to select "NAVIGATION"
3. Press the NAV button on the surround and reach the menu directly




The panel with the buttons for **Blue&Me™ Nav** is in the front courtesy light zone and enables:

- Direct access to the navigation menu by pressing the NAV button.
- Pressing the SOS button and  accesses telematic information services.
- If the service is not active then the system responds with "service not available". For further information go to the section dedicated to services.

Blue&Me™ Nav will show the warning message "THE DRIVER MUST COMPLY WITH ROAD REGULATIONS" on the display. Press SRC to continue. At this point there are two ways of proceeding to enter the destination:

1. With the steering wheel controls and by saying the names when **Blue&Me™ Nav** asks you: follow the way described in the navigation menu on the preceding page.
2. With voice commands: follow the example below.

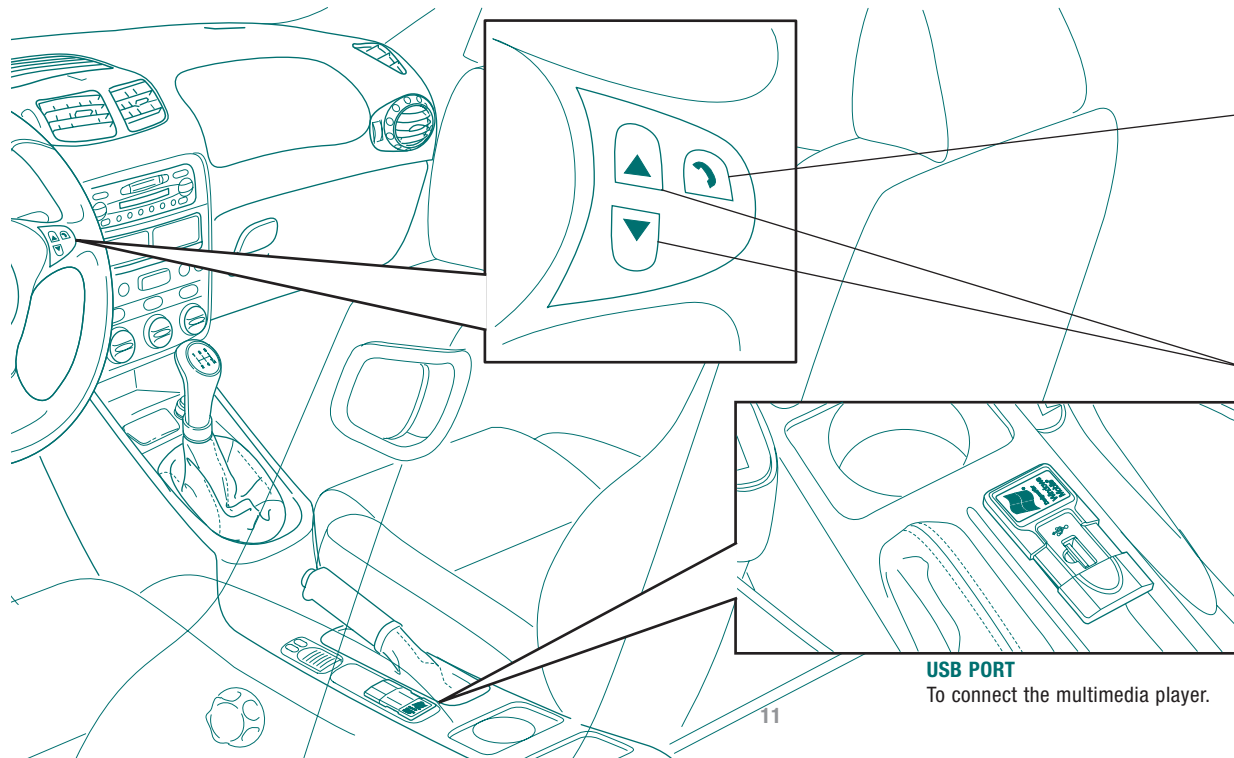
Example of entering with voice commands:

- Press the hands-free button  and say "New destination" and then "Address".
- **Blue&Me™ Nav** will ask you:
 1. The country required: say the country in which the destination to be reached is in, taking care that it is consistent with the loaded map.
 2. The city required: to be completed through manual interaction by scrolling with the buttons the characters needed to make up the name and confirming each character selected by pressing the OK button.
- As soon as you have entered the sufficient number of characters, **Blue&Me™ Nav** will suggest completing the name of the city via speech. However, it is possible to continue entering it with the steering wheel commands.
- Continue by entering the name of the destination road, using the same method as previously.
- Specify the postcode for the street of the destination by saying "Enter number" and selecting the figures with the steering wheel controls.
- Instead of the address you can also select "City Centre" in the same way.
- **Blue&Me™ Nav** will ask you to confirm the entry and if correct, give confirmation to start the navigation by saying "Start".
- From this moment the position of the car, if mapped, will appear on the control panel with the first pictogram of the address. As soon as the car is moving **Blue&Me™ Nav** will tell you the first manoeuvre to make.

NOTES FOR USING THE NAVIGATION SYSTEM

- a. The address can only be entered when the car is stationary, for road safety reasons.
- b. Other functions can be selected from the Navigation Menu when the car is moving:
 - Start navigation to a set destination from recent destinations.
 - Select a point of interest (restaurant, hotel, cinema, Group Offices, etc.) in the car's vicinity.
 - To get information about the journey: time and distance to reach the destination.
- c. All the telephone, media player and navigation functions are compatible with each other and are simultaneously managed by **Blue&Me™ Nav**.
- d. The memory stick supplied in the navigation kit is preloaded with the map of the car's country of origin or the map that was ordered at purchase.
- e. To make a back-up of the map to another USB device, use the CD that you received with the Navigation kit, insert it into your PC and follow the instructions found on the packaging.

The different maps and updates are available from the Fiat Group Automobiles official sales network. You need a 2 GB USB device to copy all the countries in Western Europe.



Short press

- Opens the main **Blue&Me™ Nav** menu.
- Accepts an incoming call.
- Switches two calls activated (call waiting).

Long press

- Refuses an incoming call.
- Ends a call in progress.




- Scroll through the menu items.
- Selects previous/next track.
- Scrolls through messages received and in the list.
- Scrolls through the characters required to compose the destination within the submenu "NEW DESTINATION".
- Scrolls through destinations stored in the submenu "RECENT DESTINATIONS".
- Scrolls the places of interest in the submenu "NEW DESTINATION".

WHAT OTHER FUNCTIONS DOES BLUE&ME™ NAV HAVE?



SMS MESSAGE READER

The incoming message is read by the system voice synthesiser, including abbreviations and smileys.

When a new SMS text message is received whilst driving, **Blue&Me™ Nav** automatically notifies you depending on the mode set: “VISUAL + ACOUSTIC”; “VISUAL” “NOT ACTIVATED”.

If “NOT ACTIVATED” is selected, the message reader will be disabled to guarantee your privacy. To listen to the last message received, using manual interaction via the “MSG PLAYER” MENU, scroll through the menu until “READ LAST” or, with voice interaction: press  and say “MESSAGE READER”, then “READ LAST”.

READ MESSAGE BEFORE/AFTER

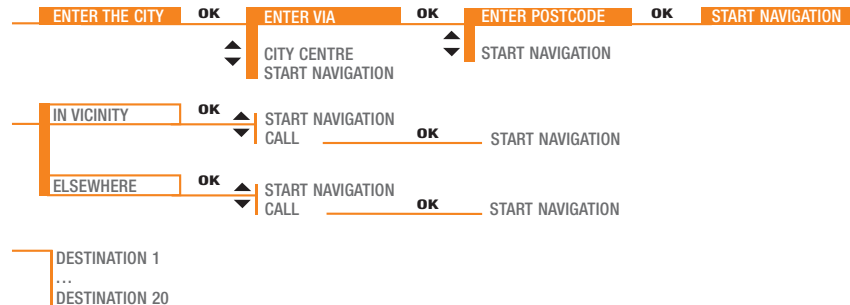
To use manual interaction to jump to the following message: press  or with voice interaction: press  and say “PREVIOUS” or “NEXT”.

NOTE: Not all mobile phones support the transfer of SMS text messages via **Bluetooth®**. Consult the website www.alfaromeo.com for the list of compatible phones.

MEDIA PLAYER

Insert the multimedia player, iPod or USB memory stick in the dedicated USB port to play the audio files through the car speakers.

It will be possible to listen to MP3, WMA, WAV audio files that are NOT covered by digital rights (e.g. Not AAC files by paid download from iTunes).
